Rom, Norway, April 13, 1940: The Germans well-executed invasion captured Oslo on April 9. The German 196 I.D. was assigned to attack southeast toward Sweden. The area was defended by the hastily mobilizing 1st Norwegian

I.D. and the 1st Artillery Regiment. The Norwegians deployed small "bridge groups" to guard the bridges over the Glama River. The Germans were able to organize a reinforced company with improvised motor transport to advance toward Fossum, Askim and the Swedish border. On the morning of April 13, elements of the 196 I.D. and 163 I.D. crossed the Glama at Fossum. Major Wilck led his untested men against the apparent passive and confounded foe.

Board Configuration:

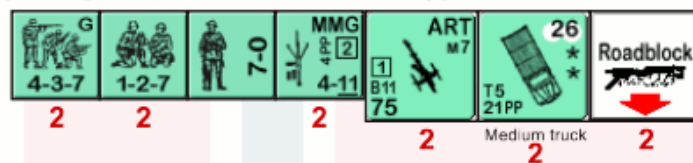


Only hexrows
A thru P are
playable.

VICTORY CONDITIONS: Germans win by exiting 20VP off east edge of Board 17. Prisoners do not count double. Exited captured equipment do not count toward VPs. Germans VPs required is reduced by 5 VP for each 75mm gun that is captured/destroyed.

Norwegians setup first. **Balance:** exchange 4-3-7s for 4-5-7s and increase ELR to 3.

Half-Battery, Artillery Regiment 1 and a MG platoon from 1st Infantry Division[ELR: 2], set up east of hexrow O: SAN {4}



1st Company, 1st Battalion, 1st Infantry Division enter on Turn 1 on/adjacent to one hex along the north/east edge of Board 10:



MG Platoon, 1st Battalion, 1st Infantry Division enter on Turn 2 on/adjacent to one hex along the east edge :



Bridge Group 4, Askim Detachment enter on Turn 3 on/adjacent to a hex along the south/west edge of Board 17.
